

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT CKC

**Q: What grades are included for this program?**

A: 1<sup>st</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> grade

**Q: Why should I send my child to Creative Kids Club Wednesdays?**

A: Parents surveyed answered things like:

*"I like knowing my child is taken care of and having fun with other kids."*

*"We cannot afford the cost or provide transportation to other activities."*

*"I like that it is Bible-based. My children have learned a lot and enjoy going."*

*"I like the creative activities; not having to worry about daycare each Wed."*

*". . . the loving, nurturing CKC staff."*

**Q: What is the cost of the program?**

A: It's **FREE!** Parents may make donations to defray costs of snacks/supplies.

**Q: How will my child get to Creative Kids Club?**

A: Children meet in the Pope gymnasium where they sign in and get a name tag. With your permission, our volunteers will ESCORT your child from Pope to SHCC each Wednesday. **Parents pick children up at SHCC at 3:00 pm**

**Q: What is the basic schedule for Creative Kids Club?**

A: The general plan each week will be:

- 12:45 – 1:00 **Registration/Station selection**
- 1:00 – 1:10 **Music/Introduction of Bible Theme for the day**
- 1:10 – 2:00 **Exploration Stations** (See below)
- 2:00 – 2:20 **Clean Up/Snack**
- 2:20 – 2:50 **Bible Lesson**
- 2:50 – 3:00 **Worship**
- **3:00 pm DISMISSAL/ PARENTS PICK UP**


**Q: What are the Exploration Stations?**

A: Children will have their choice of activities each week. Choices will likely be:

- **CREATION STATION:** Variety of art supplies/ideas to make fun art projects.
- **KIDS KITCHEN:** Children prepare a special snack for the club to enjoy.
- **SEWING:** Simple, sewing supplies – fabric, yarn, etc.
- **DRAMA/PUPPETS:** Children will use costumes, puppets, and props to put on skits or puppet shows for other groups to watch during sharing time.
- **RECREATION STATION:** Physical skills/sports
- **LARGE/SMALL BLOCKS:** Variety of interlocking blocks
- **CONSTRUCTION:** Children will be closely supervised as they use hammers, nails, vice grips, etc. to build simple items - birdhouses, cars, boxes
- **PUZZLES/GAMES:** We will put out a variety of games and puzzles for children to play alone or in groups together.
- **QUIET CORNER:** We will have books and tables for quiet reading or homework activities.

**Q: How will my child be supervised?**

A: We limit enrollment based on volunteers. We prefer 1-2 leaders per 10 children. Volunteers will be screened by the Washington State Patrol, and trained and supervised by SHCC staff to observe high standards of care & safety,
